I propos ed	I didn't propose	Did I propose?
You propos ed	You didn't propose	Did you propose?
She propos ed	She didn't propose	Did she propose?
He propos ed	He didn't propose	Did he propose?
It propos ed	It didn't propose	Did it propose?
We propos ed	We didn't propose	Did we propose?
They propos ed	They didn't propose	Did they propose?



WE ALSO LEARNED THAT IRREGULAR VERBS **CHANGED TOTALLY IN THE AFFIRMATIVE FORM**, BUT NOT IN THE NEGATIVE AND INTERROGATIVE .
