**Description of the assignment**

- Each student must present an individual oral presentation in which they represent their future professions.
- The student must answer the 15 questions in an online document or in his/her copybook, and then, create a script which will be recorded. (Arial 11 - Justificado)
- The audio must last between 1.50 minutes to 2.00 minutes long.
- The date of presentation will be said/decided by the teacher.

6. Script (Final Revision)	Student shows a complete script with all the questions answered.	Student shows an incomplete script.	Student doesn't show any script.
7. Vocabulary	Student uses and highlight the 8 words in the script.	Student uses and highlight less than 8 words in the script.	Student don't use and don't highlight the 8 words in the script.
8. Greeting	The student starts the presentation by formally greeting.	The student starts the presentation by informally greeting.	The student does not start the presentation by formally greeting.
9. Fluency	The student says the presentation in large phrases and smoothly.	The student says the presentation with more than 2 stops per phrase.	The student says the presentation with more than 3 stops and not smoothly.
10. Pronunciation	The student does not have mistakes in the pronunciation of words.	The student has from 1 to 3 mistakes in the pronunciation of words.	The student has more than 4 mistakes in the pronunciation of words.
