


Grammar Content: Present Perfect Tense

WE USE PRESENT PERFECT TO EXPRESS AN ACTION OR SITUATION THAT STARTED IN THE PAST AND CONTINUES IN THE PRESENT. **Present Perfect** Past Simple

TO FORM THE PRESENT PERFECT, WE NEED:

HAVE / HAS + VERB IN PAST PARTICIPLE
