
## <u>"English as an International Language"</u>

There have been many **attempts** to create an artificial language which would **bridge** the **gap** in communication between people of different nationalities. Among the languages that have been created, *Esperanto* has had most **success**. Practically, however, English has become an international language around the globe. It would not be true to say that most people in the world speak this language. Only Chinese is spoken by more people but it is used only in one country.

1. Do you agree that English is an International Language? Why?



In the past, England was a superpower in *ruling* the world, but it had many rivals in politics, economics, geography, science and culture. Among the countries which tried to *attain* the power in the world were France, Germany, Netherlands and Spain. But, that race to power was won by England which was leading in most *fields*. The geographical discoveries of the 17th and 18th centuries, the colonial empire, the industrial revolution of the 19th century and the role which the British and the American armies played in both world wars contributed to making English the predominant language in the international communication.



English has become the language of pop music, not only because of famous English and American singers like Elvis Presley or the Beatles, but, because English has short, easily rhyming words which are a perfect *ground* for pop music.

In many countries in the world some people try to protect their native languages from the English influence, but it is not easy to find substitutes for such words as 'hamburger', 'hot-dog', 'supermarket', 'hit' or 'make-up'. That is why, many English words are used internationally.
